William Street originally was a two-way street and City of Perth made the decision to reinstate the two-way traffic flow.

This decision is only one part of the redevelopment of this entire area. Murray Street Mall has already been upgraded and the Forrest Place Overpass has been removed. These changes will overhaul the City Centre attracting many new businesses to William Street.

Construction was completed on this Upgrade Project in 2008.
